Conflict Minerals Policy Statement

Cyclone Microsystems supports the worldwide effort to eliminate the usage of conflict metals mined in the areas of the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) from making their way into the electronics supply chain. As a participant in the electronic supply chain, we work with our suppliers to ensure that no conflict materials are knowingly in any Cyclone Microsystems products.

Suppliers are expected to ensure that parts and products supplied to Cyclone Microsystems are DRC conflict free (do not contain metals derived from conflict minerals; tantalum, tin, tungsten, gold such that they directly or indirectly finance or benefit armed groups through mining or mineral trading in the Democratic Republic of the Congo or an adjoining country). Suppliers are to establish policies, due diligence frameworks and management systems that are designed to accomplish this goal.

Cyclone Microsystems surveys our suppliers regarding sourcing and procurement of gold, tin, tantalum and tungsten based on results and in reliance of the information provided by our suppliers, confirms that any of the aforementioned metals used by our supply chain and included in our products are not knowingly derived or sourced from mines in DRC conflict areas and are DRC conflict free.
